MODERN OBSTACLES TO CURE AND HOW TO TREAT THEM

They present challenges for any practitioner. With reference to the Organon, Jon will walk you through these three major areas, the types of tests you can do to reveal them, and how to treat them by using homeopathy in an innovative way.
