Peter has been in full-time homeopathic and naturopathic practice for 30 years now and was co-founder, and principal of the Sydney College of Homeopathic Medicine. He has travelled to India, Britain and Europe to further his understanding and interact with practitioners who are at the cutting edge of energetic medicine. He is also a qualified gemmologist and has travelled widely to collect and mine gems for preparing homeopathic medicines.

In 2005 he completed his major work on medicines made from crystals called "Twelve Jewels". It is the result of 10 years of experimenting, writing and working at the coalface of clinical practice. He uses these medicines extensively in his practice and recently published a further work on the gems in his book 'Rose Quartz, Garden of the Heart'.

He has conducted seminars in the UK, Europe, USA and Australia and is the author of numerous journal articles on medicines made from crystals.
