REMOVING OBSTACLES TO CURE - THE ROLE OF INTEGRATIVE MEDICINE

Judith is a qualified homoeopath and naturopath who has been in practice in Sydney since 1999. A large portion of her practice is children with chronic, complex diseases such as autism, ADHD, obesity, diabetes, asthma and allergies to name a few. She also has a Science degree with majors in Haematology and Immunology and has worked in routine medical laboratories before specialising in research. Her research has included work with the Red Cross in transplant medicine, cancer research specifically in melanoma research with the University of Sydney and the Melanoma Unit at RPA. And finally, research in neurobiology on Bipolar, Schizophrenia and Alzheimer's at the Garvan Institute, Sydney.

In this session, Judith will give us an overview of how she has incorporated an integrative approach to unravel and make sense of the many different symptoms and behaviours now seen in our practices. Judith will also explain which tests need to be incorporated into our practice and how the results can be a powerful guide to aid us in unlocking difficult cases, clearing the way for successful treatment. This promises to be very worthwhile if you want to learn more about combining laboratory testing and homeopathy to address gut issues, food intolerances, heavy metals etc.
