I began my working life as a teacher. After graduating from Newcastle University in 1971 with a BA DipEd, I taught in NSW before moving to western Queensland with my husband in

1972. I taught full time and then part time in Mount Isa until 1980, and that early professional experience underpins my passion for Materia Medica and the desire to share all manner of insights, both through writing as well as teaching. Teachers just can't help themselves in that regard!

The interest in breastfeeding stems from goodness knows where, but my dolls and teddy bears can well attest to the fact that the commitment to nurturing in that way was with me from my early childhood. As a mother of 3 children I lactated for over 6 years; and, if I'd known then what I know now, I would have breastfed for longer. Did you know that primates lactate for 6 times the gestation rate?

My interest in natural therapies began after a health crisis following the birth of my second child in 1977 when I suffered a detached retina. After working part-time in a homœopathic clinic in the late '80s, I decided

to go back to full-time study and was awarded a Bachelor Health Science (Homœopathy).

As well as being registered with the Australian Register of Homœopaths (AROH), I am a professional member of the following:

- Australian Naturopathic Practitioners Association (ANPA)
- Effectiveness Training Institute of Australia (ETIA)

I have been in private practice as a homœopath since 1995 and have a busy practice. Although I offer classical homœopathic treatment for individual complaints of people of all ages with all manner of conditions, because of my unique combination of clinical skills in lactation as well as homœopathy, I have a particular interest and expertise in treating women and children, especially babies (most commonly with respect to colic and reflux). A large portion of my clientele seeks help for infertility, a wide range of breastfeeding problems (such as mastitis, thrush and white spot) and the treatment of all manner of behavioural problems in children.

I publish a regular newsletter 'Milk Matters' and have written two books:
