Vivienne has been treating patients in Sydney since 1994 after graduating from the

Vivienne was born in South Africa, attended university in the U.K, and completed a B.A. Honours (Manchester Uni) and Postgrad Textiles (Leeds Uni).

Simply stated, the health system is failing to cope with the escalating numbers. The human tragedy is that more and more parents will outlive their children.

### As homoeopaths how can we help?

Statistically speaking, all practicing homoeopaths will have diabetic spectrum patients. At this seminar, Vivienne will discuss the identification of patients at risk, responsible patient management and the importance of Blood Glucose Control.
